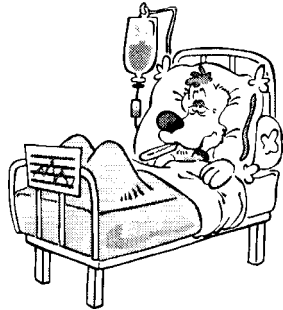

Most surgical cases are treated as "Day Care" so that they can return home to their owners the same evening. Occasionally, however, it may be better to have the animal hospitalised for treatment and observation. You will be updated regularly on your pet's progress whilst it is with us.

On the day:

1. No food from 10.00pm the previous night. Water is permissible.
2. Come to the surgery between 8.30 and 10.30am or as prearranged.
3. Please allow your pet to "spend a penny", if possible, before arrival.
4. For safety's sake, please have your dogs on leads, and cats in baskets.
5. Try not to worry.
6. If you have any queries on what is planned, please either ring us or discuss it with the nurse who admits your pet.
7. 'Tracer' microchips can be placed whilst your pet is anaesthetised. If you would like this to be done please inform the nurse on admission.
8. On admission you will be offered a 'pre-anaesthetic blood sample' for your pet.

Going home:

1. Please ring at 1.30pm to check your pet's discharge time and what the fee is.
2. It is usual to pay at the time of collection. If your pet is insured please bring a claim form with you.
 3. When you telephone, please make arrangements for collection, usually between 3.30 and 6.30pm.
4. Full instructions on how to care for your pet will be given.
